

# Western Music Network

## How to prepare the dataset and use the visualization

1. Create a google doc
2. Enter the connected musicians separated by a dash '-' in one single line as follows:  
**Beethoven-Haydn**  
**Beethoven-Mozart**  
**Haydn-Mozart**  
**Beethoven-Mendelssohn**
3. For the first entrance, this means that Beethoven has a direct connection with Haydn and the next line means that Beethoven has a direct connection with Mozart and so on.  
**Note:** it's one connection per line
4. Download as a **\*.txt** file on Google Docs.
5. To add the file to the visualization, click the **choose file** option on the web page and chose the \*.txt file you just saved.
6. After that click **Upload File** to add the file data to the visualization
7. A network graph is supposed to appear and if it doesn't, click the circles that appear usually on the top right section of the display after uploading the file.
8. You can now move your network around by clicking and dragging a single node.

Hovering above any node, highlights it's links to it's children as well as all the children that particular node is connected to.
